

Southport After School Enrichment FALL 2019 Class Descriptions

*****NEW*** Intro to Crafts- TUESDAYS (grades TK-1): Our smallest of Students will create various arts and crafts projects crafted for their little minds.**

*****NEW*** Intro to STEM- TUESDAYS (grades 1-4): An introduction to STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) through hands-on exploration.**

*****NEW*** Mini Day SHOOT FOR THE STARS- MINI WEDNESDAYS (grades TK-8): This class will be focused on assisting students where they need help. Homework help, reading development, fun math games, binder organizing. This Class will be a bridge from mini after school classes to extend the day to 3:45pm on mini days.**

*****NEW*** Yoga- FRIDAYS (grades 1-4. Kinder with teacher approval): Breathing and movement techniques to calm, energize, and balance the nervous system.**

*****NEW*** Career Exploration: This class will spend each week exploring a different career but local community members and business professionals .**

Computer Science - MONDAYS OR FRIDAYS (see schedule)(grades 2-8): Provides exposure to computer skills through a variety of software programs. Students with less computer skills will work on fundamentals while more advanced students will do more complex programs.

Spanish 1 and 2- (see schedule): This program is an afterschool language enrichment program that will follow an immersion curriculum created by El Sombrero Time. The program supports all areas of Spanish language development. THE PROGRAM IS NOT INTENDED FOR STUDENTS WHO SPEAK SPANISH AT HOME.

Photography- MONDAYS (grades 5-8): Students will learn the basics of digital photography composition and design elements, and editing.

Martial Arts-THURSDAYS (grades K-8): Through martial arts students gain increased confidence and focus as well as discipline. See www.atasouthport.com

Intro to Cheerleading- TUESDAYS (grades 1-4): Learn all of the fundamentals of cheerleading. Cheers, Motions, Dance, Jumps, Kicks, and Voice Projection.

Mini Day Art- MINI WEDNESDAYS (grades 2-8): The Crocker Art Museum will work with students on their creativity through different mediums of art.

Mini Day Garden Club- MINI WEDNESDAYS (grades K-8): Students will explore themes related to conservation as well as participate and work in the school garden.

Mini Day Golf/Tennis- MINI WEDNESDAYS (grades K-8): 2 separate 9 week sessions. Both Sessions Taught by TGA Premier Golf and Tennis. Developed by TGA's education experts and PGA and LPGA, USTA golf and tennis professionals **1st session = Golf: Focus on instilling a passion for golf, developing skills, having fun, and building confidence. **2nd session = Tennis:** Focus on instilling a passion for tennis, developing skills, having fun and building confidence.**

Mini Day Spanish 1- (TK/K) 11:45-12:45 and Mini Day Spanish 2- (grades 1-3) 1:20-2:30 MINI WEDNESDAYS ONLY: This language program is geared toward the younger child and focuses on language exposure and vocabulary through fun songs and games. This class may be a good prerequisite for the Spanish 1.

After Care add for Mini Spanish 1- (TK/K) 12:45-1:10 - This options is for students who need extra care in order to attend another class or to simplify pick up options for parents with an older sibling.

Advanced Craft/Sewing Club- THURSDAYS (grades 2-8): Students will create crafts and learn different sewing techniques.

Advanced Cheerleading- THURSDAYS (grades 4-8): Learn all of the fundamentals of cheerleading. Cheers, Motions, Dance, Jumps, Kicks, and Voice Projection.

STEM Academy- FRIDAYS (grades 5-8): Taught by Square Root Academy (<https://www.squarerootacademy.com>)

Expose scholars to the fundamentals of STEM. Promote academic empowerment by bridging the gap between STEM related concepts learned in the classroom and real world applications. Increase STEM literacy among participating scholars. Expose scholars to degreed STEM professionals providing a mentor in the STEM realm.
