*****NEW Cheerleading TUESDAYS (grades 1-4) or THURSDAYS (grades 4-8):**

Students are guided through the key principles of contemporary musical theatre dance, which will provide students with a sound knowledge of the basic technique, movement, coordination, and confidence.

*****NEW Mini Day Tennis/Golf- MINI WEDNESDAYS (grades K-8): 2 separate 9 week sessions**

*****NEW STEM Academy- FRIDAYS (grades 5-8): Taught by Square Root Academy (<https://www.squarerootacademy.com>)**

1. To expose scholars to the fundamentals of STEM and project based education aligned with Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS)
2. Promote academic empowerment by bridging the gap between STEM related concepts learned in the classroom and real world applications
3. Increase STEM literacy among participating scholars
4. Expose scholars to degreed STEM professionals providing a mentor in the STEM realm

Over the duration of the program scholars will be exposed to: Additive manufacturing (3D modeling and printing),Coding (C++),Electronics (Circuit design and creation), Design thinking,Many other industries related concepts. Students will also go on one field trip. Once enrolled the student will be sent an application and student pact that must be returned to confirm enrollment.

Computer Science - MONDAY OR FRIDAY (see schedule)(grades 2-8): Provides exposure to computer skills through a variety of software programs. Students with less computer skills will work on fundamentals while more advanced students will do more complex programs.

Craft/Sewing Club- THURSDAYS (grades 2-8): Students will create crafts and learn different sewing techniques.

Martial Arts- TUESDAY or THURSDAY (grades K-8): Through martial arts students gain increased confidence and focus as well as discipline. Martial arts training is great for kids to excel individually while working with their fellow classmates as a team. See www.atasouthport.com

Spanish 1 and 2- (see schedule): This program is an afterschool language enrichment program that will follow an immersion curriculum created by El Sombrero Time (www.sombrerotime.com). The program supports all areas of Spanish language development including reading, writing, speaking and listening. THE PROGRAM IS NOT INTENDED FOR STUDENTS WHO SPEAK SPANISH AT HOME.

Photography- MONDAYS (grades 5-8): Students will learn the basics of digital photography composition and design elements, and editing.

Mini Art- MINI WEDNESDAYS (grades 2-8): The Crocker Art Museum will work with students on their creativity through different mediums of art while also learning aspects of art history.

Mini Garden Club- MINI WEDNESDAYS (grades K-8): Students will explore themes related to conservation as well as participate and work in the school garden.

Mini Spanish 1- (TK/K) 11:45-12:45 and Mini Spanish 2- (grades 1-3) 1:20-2:30 MINI WEDNESDAYS ONLY: This language program is geared toward the younger child and focuses on language exposure and vocabulary through fun songs and games. This class may be a good prerequisite for the Spanish 1.

After Care add on:Mini Spanish 1- (TK/K) 12:45-1:10 - This options is for students who need extra care in order to attend another class or to simplify pick up options for parents with an older sibling.
