

Nouns - people, places, and things.

**<u>Common nouns</u>** – people, places, and things not named [child, school, pen]

**Proper nouns** – names particular people, places, and things and are capitalized [Tommy, Southport Elementary, Bic]

<u>Collective nouns</u> - a special class of nouns- name groups [things] composed of members [usually people]. Examples include: *audience, army, team* 

<u>Action verb</u> – words that show action [run, yell, talk]

**Pronouns** – words that rename a noun [he, she, it, them]

**Possessive pronouns** – pronouns that show possession [hers, theirs, his]

**Reflexive pronouns** – are usually used when the object of a sentence is the same as the subject [myself, themselves]

<u>Adjectives</u> – words that describe nouns [red, tall, soft, sour]

<u>Adverbs</u> – words that describe verbs...often end in *-ly* [quickly, softly]
